- Review of Civilian Complaint Form:
 - PD needs to add a better explanation of the Civilian Complaint process including response time.
 - Past student stated the form was not working correctly. – tested and confirmed working correctly by Joe Mauss and at least one other faculty member during the meeting.

Leticia Maldonado spoke about Title IX and the advocacy system.

- Filing a complaint with the Office of Student Affairs is different from filing a complaint with the Police Department.
 - Leticia & Chief Acosta discussed the differences between an Advocacy Report and the Police Department's Civilian Complaint Form.
- Working on an advocacy program to assist students with navigating the Administrative Hearing process and aiding with interacting with the Police Department
